

The Competition and Marketing Authority require that all Funeral Directors display a 'Standardised Price List' to allow consumers to compare costs at a glance on a like for like basis. Our price list is based on our basic funeral package.

Attended Funeral (**funeral director's charges only**)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	£1790
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£720
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£250
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at our premises, 207 Strathmartine Road, Dundee DD3 8PH	£240
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from veneered wood and have a flat lid.	£325
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the family).	
<i>*By law a fee must be listed here but it will not be charged.</i>	£1*
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£255

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£685
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) ²	£1150

Fees you must pay

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**.

Additional funeral director products and services

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them.
Examples include:

¹This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

²In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
